Advent and the Jesse Tree

This Sunday is the Third Sunday of Advent, which is a season of preparation for the Lord's coming. The theme for this week is **Joy**.

God of Joy, it is in your love that we find lasting joy in the gift of your Son, who came into this world with nothing, yet gave us everything. May his joy fill our hearts and overflow to all we encounter.



Each week in Advent the children will attach a picture or symbol to the Jesse Tree.
